But, even by those seemingly unattainable goals, Danish experts Gryphon stands head and shoulders above most of the rest. Take the Diablo 120 integrated amplifier and Mojo S stand-mount loudspeaker for example. They are archetypes of what high-end audio should look and sound like, and where most companies would be proud to have a pair of products such as the 120W Diablo 120 with its extensive range of analogue and digital inputs, and the bass-tunable D'Appolito-AMT three-way Mojo S as their flagship products, these unashamedly 'spendy' products are merely Gryphon's starting place.

Roy Gregory sampled the delights of these two designs in combination. He was impressed! "This Gryphon rig 'does' dynamics.
